B	Pedagogy and presentation style	20 %
C	Peer review	20 %
D	Participation	20 %
E	Attendance	20 %

- A: Impact of the results presented. If it is a review work, reduce 5 points and grade it for critical analysis of literature.
- B: Pedagogy component of the presentation.
- C: Give a report of at least one presentation. Review report has to be in the spirit of a referee report, like journal articles. A minimum of one reiew report is required.
- D: Constructive participation during presentations by asking questions and giving comments to speakers.
- E: Attendance.
