Question

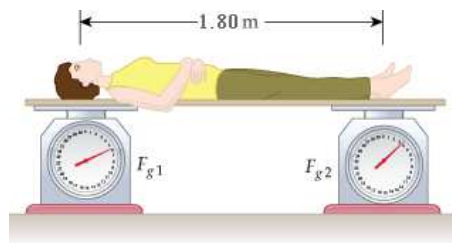


Figure 1: Center of mass.

The center of mass of a person may be determined by an arrangement shown in Figure 1 below. A light (massless) plank rests on two scales separated by a distance equal to the height $h = 1.80\text{ m}$ of the person. The scales that measure the normal forces read $N_1 = F_{g1} = 500.0\text{ N}$ and $N_2 = F_{g2} = 300.0\text{ N}$. Determine the distance of the girl's center of mass from her feet.
